Tournament Format

A. Qualification

Entries, 6 games, Re-entries, 6 games

B. Early Bird Competition

A separate standing for athletes playing in Squad 1-5

C. Female Bowlers Competition

A separate standing for Female Bowlers

D. Youth Bowlers Competition

A separate standing for Youth Bowlers

A Youth Bowler must not reach the age of 18 when the tournament is played.

E. Senior 50+ Bowlers Competition

A separate standing for Senior 50+ Bowlers

A Senior 50+ Bowler must be 50 years of age or older at the first day of the tournament.

F. Turbo (game 5 and 6)

Turbo refers to the highest score in game 5+6

G. Desperado

One game from scratch, TOP 2 will advance, desperado will be played after the last qualifying squad. Desperado will be played only on one lane without reiling the lanes. Not CROSSLANE.

The highest scores in Turbo provide 2 best athletes for the final. Registration for the Turbo must be made during registration and payment, which must takeplace before the squad starts and is valid only for the squad just entered. The entry fee for Turbo is 10 euro for each squad.

38 athletes will qualify for the final steps.

A: 26 athletes from the general standing

B: 4 athletes from the Early Bird Competition

C: 1 athlete from the Female Bowlers Competition

D: 1 athlete from the Youth Bowlers Competition

E: 2 athletes from the Senior 50+ Bowlers Competition

F: 2 athletes from the Turbo

G: 2 athletes from Desperado

Order of qualification

An athlete will qualify only once and always in the listed order starting from A.

If an athlete is qualified from more than one category, the next positioned athlete from the category, not valid for the already qualified athlete, will qualify instead.

The 38 athletes are qualified to final steps as follows.

Athletes positioned 1-8 in the general standing are qualified for the Final Step 3.

Athletes positioned 9-18 in the general standing are qualified for the Final Step 2.

All other 20 qualified athletes are qualified for the Final Step 1.

Final step 1

20 athletes are playing 4 games starting from scratch.

Athletes positioned 1-10 is qualified for the final step 2.

Athletes not qualified are ranked 29-38 according to their position in Step 1.

Final step 2

20 athletes will play 4 games starting from scratch.

Athletes positioned 1-8 is qualified for the final step 3.

Athletes not qualified are ranked 17-28 according to their position in Step 2.

Final step 3

16 athletes will play 4 games starting from scratch.

Athletes positioned 1-8 is qualified for the final step 4.

Athletes not qualified are ranked 9-16 according to their position in Step 3.

Final step 4

8 athletes will be placed in two groups according to their position in Step 3.

Position 1,4,5,8 in group one, position 2,3,6,7 in group two.

Each group of 4 athletes will play an elimination over 3 one game rounds.

The 3 one game rounds will each take place, with each group on a separate pair of lanes, and game 2 and 3 will continue on the same pair of lanes, right after the conclusion off the previous game.

In each round the lowest scoring athletes will be leaving the elimination.

The athletes winning each group will play a final one-game match on a separate pair of lanes.

Each round is starting from scratch.

The athletes leaving the first round will be ranked 7 & 8 according to their position in Step 3.

The athletes leaving the second round will be ranked 5 & 6 according to their position in Step 3.

The athletes leaving the third round will be ranked 3 & 4 according to their position in Step 3.

The loser of the final one-game match will be ranked 2.

The winner of the final one-game match will be ranked 1.

Senior Final

The top 16 senior players qualify for the Senior

Final, which will take place on the final day of the tournament (**May 3, 2026 at 13:00**).

The Senior Final will be played in three steps (stages).

Senior Final – Step 1

16 seniors will play 3 games from scratch.

Seniors placed 1st–8th qualify for Senior Final – Step 2.

Players who do not qualify will be ranked 9th–16th based on their results in Senior Final – Step 1.

Lane assignments are based on the Senior Ranking after Qualification.

Senior Final – Step 1 will be played on lanes 1–4 and 7–10.

Senior Final – Step 2

8 seniors will play 3 games from scratch.

Seniors placed 1st–4th qualify for Senior Final – Step 3.

Players who do not qualify will be ranked 5th–8th based on their results in Senior Final – Step 2.

Lane assignments are based on the results of Senior Final – Step 1.

Senior Final – Step 2 will be played on lanes 1–4 and 7–10, without re-oiling.

Senior Final – Step 3

4 seniors will play 3 elimination games, with the senior having the lowest score eliminated after each game.

Final standings are determined by the results in Senior Final – Step 3.

Senior Final – Step 3 will be played on lanes 5–6.

Tournament tie rules

Qualification / Early Birds / Senior 50+, Youth and Female Competitions

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest second last game etc.

Turbo and Desperado

In case of tie, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest position after the qualification.

Final Step 1-3

Ties influencing who will qualify for the next final step will be broken by playing a 9th and 10th frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken. In all other tie situations in step 1-3, a procedure like the procedure for the qualification will be followed.

Final step 4 (elimination matches)

In case of a tie, decisive for a continuation from Round 1 or 2, or decisive for the outcome of Round 3 and in the final one-game match, a one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.

Lane assignments and lane movements
